Life Balance and Family Focus

SICHC is located in a rural area of Indiana, but it is remarkably close – generally within in an hour's drive or less – to superb amenities and a surprising variety of great activities. You can have the life-enhancing environment of the beautiful southern Indiana countryside together with nearby world-class entertainment, music, shopping, wineries, sports, outdoor life/recreation, and more.

SICHC recognizes that professional life as a physician can be taxing and challenging, so physicians work a reasonable call schedule of 1 in 4 and participate in a family-friendly paid time off (PTO) schedule. Other SICHC advantages include:

- Salary guaranteed through contract
- Opportunities for sign-on bonus and reimbursement of moving expenses
- Student loan/debt repayment through National Service Corp programs
- CME Allowance – five days a year (up to \$4,000 annually)



- 401(k) – participation after first year, with a corporate match up to 4%
- Strong healthcare, vision, dental and other voluntary benefits
- 2:1 support staff to off-load documentation burden
- A supportive and flexible onboarding period

The southern Indiana region offers a surprising variety of excellent housing and good schools, high-speed internet, and community opportunities. Two interstates cross the region, allowing easy access to major airports, urban amenities, and more.

Your Options at SICHC

Primary Care – with the full support of experienced staff and family nurse practitioners, physicians work in a positive team environment. Often SICHC patients come from low income or impoverished environments, and SICHC serves as a safety net provider to meet the needs of our region.

Obstetrics – Just a few years ago, the rural region that SICHC serves was in jeopardy of becoming an obstetrics desert. SICHC provided a leadership role in helping positively resolve that issue. Today, SICHC offers high-quality, evidenced-based OB care, including ultrasounds. C-Section Preceptorship is available (if desired). Physicians have privileges at the nearby IU Health Paoli Hospital (<https://iuhealth.org/find-locations/iu-health-paoli-hospital>) for deliveries (including C-sections).

And More – You can truly fulfill your potential and passion for medical excellence at SICHC, all guided by your personal spiritual commitment. SICHC services include chronic disease management, integrated behavioral health, substance abuse recovery programs, nursing home care, and more. SICHC physicians also have the opportunity to provide continuity of care with hospital rounding, and to collaborate with top rural health researchers at Indiana University.
